



## Explanation about the transfer functionality of IBI Go (1.9)

IBI Go makes it possible to email a list of addresses. This saves you time entering an address manually and you can link IBI with your back office.

The address in a txt file can be written in various ways. This is an example of the variants. Please note that you do not use column titles, only address data. Also note that every line should always contain two semicolons, this is to differentiate between the address, note and number column.




After the address (1) there is space for 2 extra fields with information. (2) is text for remark and (3) is a mobile number, which can be used for sending a SMS.




Send the file as an attachment to a unique email address, linked to your IBI license. The text in the subject of the email will be used in the file list in the IBI app.

The lists that have been received via email are shown in the menu under the button **Receive**.






**Swipe** to left (on iPhone) and click on **Use list**.


The list can be added to the active list. If you prefer to use the new emailed list only, then first empty the currently active list (the **Empty** option).







The new list appears with addresses and comments. However, phone numbers will not be shown. Swipe down to let IBI sort the addresses in the most optimal route.






Go to menu to **Transfer** addresses.


Select the addresses you want to transfer by clicking on them. Then click on **Transfer**.







The transferred addresses are shown in the overview of address lists.

The transferred addresses are have been marked with date and time.

To use one of the lists, click on **Use list**.

The list will be added to the current active list. If this is not your intention, you need first to remove the old list first.
